2. COMPUTER INFORMATION

The central computing services will establish a local wireless network that can be accessed inside the lecture rooms. If you do not have a laptop then you can use a guest account in the computer lab in the basement of the Mathematics Building.

3. MENSA INFORMATION

The main building of the Mensa is currently closed. We have arranged to have a cash register in the (temporary) dining hall in the chemistry building on Friday. On Saturday we can use the Mensa of the University of Applied Sciences (Fachhochschule) Regensburg. It is a 10 minutes walk from the mathematics building (in the direction of the train station) to get there. Moreover, the little Pizzeria on campus will be open on Saturday.

Coffee is available from the little cart between mathematics and physics and from the Pizzeria on the main square of the campus (exit the mathematics building, go straight, take the underpass under the main administration and keep right). Ask for coffee "zum Mitnehmen" or talk to the guys in Italian. We will also serve refreshments during the breaks in the lounge in room 201.

5. GETTING FROM THE TRAIN STATION/CITY CENTER TO CAMPUS

Bus connections to the University. The easiest way is to take a local bus. The 6 runs to the Klinikum (hospital), the 11 to Burgweinting. During rush hour, some buses run as a **6S** to the Klinikum only (**no stop at the Universität**). There is additionally an 11S that runs to the Universität only (and not to Burgweinting).

You can buy tickets from the machines at the bus stops and on the buses (but they are more expensive).

Leaving from the train station. The University is in the South of the train station. The easiest way to get there is to use public transportation. To get to the bus stop, exit the train station toward the historic city center (facing north). Outside of the station you will see on your right-hand side (the north ramp of) a bridge going across the railroad tracks. Both buses leave on this ramp of the bridge. You get there by taking a diagonal across the little park on the other side of the main road in front of the station, slightly to your right. There is a display showing your the next departure times at the bus stop.

Arriving on campus. Both buses (6, 11/11S) stop at "Universität Mensa". If you are on a 6 bus, take the stairs at the bus stop, cross the road on the overpass and walk straight, passing the Mensa (currently under constructions) on your right and the administration/convenience stores on your left. Take the few steps uphill and you will see the math building slightly on your left. The office of GD is in room 227. If you take the 11, you will end up on the other side of the road. Take the stairs close to the bus stop, do not cross the road, and proceed as if you had arrived on a 6 bus.

6. GETTING TO REGENSBURG

By train. Regensburg lies on the route from Frankfurt to Vienna. Check

for connections.

*WARNING: since 4/1/07 you **cannot** buy your train ticket for local trains on the train anymore. You **must** buy your ticket before you board the train. You can still buy tickets on IC/ICE trains but they are more expensive.*

By plane. The closest airports are Nürnberg and Munich.

Arriving at Munich: The airport is located 30km North of Munich, roughly 100km South of Regensburg. The closest rail station (DB www.bahn.de) is Freising; a local bus connects all terminals to long term parking and the rail station (DB) in Freising. For a schedule of the bus, please see

and follow the "transportation links". The ride on the local bus will take you 20-25min. Trains to Regensburg run every sixty minutes, currently approximately 10 minutes after the hour. Travel time to Regensburg is about one hour.

You can buy your ticket for the bus and the train from a DB ticket counter in the airport, follow the rail signs. Note that a DB ticket is valid on all trains running from Freising to Regensburg, including the ALEX trains operated by ARRIVA. You cannot buy ALEX-tickets at the DB ticket machines; buy a DB ticket instead. Also, you cannot buy the bus ticket at the ticket machine or online.

If you have bought DB tickets online before, then you might want to buy the ticket from Freising to Regensburg online. You can pay the driver on the bus for the local bus from the airport the Freising.

If you anticipate to have a long wait at the train station in Freising, then you might want to skip one or two of the shuttle buses and enjoy coffee/the shopping experience at the airport.

Arriving at Nürnberg: The train ride on a local commuter train from the airport to the main station takes you only 12 minutes. The travel time from the main station to Regensburg is approximately 1h both on local and on IC/ICE trains. Please check the schedule online.
